

XALKORI (crizotinib) GENERAL FAQs

When will XALKORI be available for patients in the United States?

XALKORI is available immediately through a number of specialty pharmacies including U.S. Bioservices (www.usbioservices.com, 1-877-757-0667), CuraScript (www.curascript.com, 1-888-773-7376) and Walgreens (www.WalgreensHealth.com, 1-888-347-3416). Patients prescribed XALKORI can call 1-877-744-5675 for assistance accessing the medication.

What is Pfizer going to do to help patients pay for XALKORI? Will all patients be eligible?

Pfizer is committed to helping eligible patients prescribed XALKORI gain access to the medication, and offers the Pfizer First Resource® Program to facilitate this process. The program will connect insured patients to specialty pharmacies for reimbursement support services and to obtain their medicines. Pfizer has also developed a co-pay assistance program for patients with ALK-positive advanced NSCLC who are prescribed XALKORI. This offer helps eligible, privately-insured patients pay no more than \$100 per month for their XALKORI prescription. Certain financial and other restrictions apply. Do patients need to be tested using the Abbott ALK FISH test in order to be prescribed XALKORI? Are other ALK testing methods approved for use with XALKORI? How much will the Abbott ALK FISH test cost?

XALKORI is indicated for the treatment of patients with locally advanced or metastatic non-small cell lung cancer (NSCLC) that is anaplastic lymphoma kinase (ALK)-positive as detected by an FDA-approved test.

While a variety of assays are currently used to detect ALK, the Abbott ALK FISH test is the only FDA-approved test at this point in time.
